It is a community-based program as part of your child's Early Intervention services. A supportive, language-rich environment for children with hearing loss gives the opportunity to continue developing overall skills with peers, and teachers who have their specialized needs in mind.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

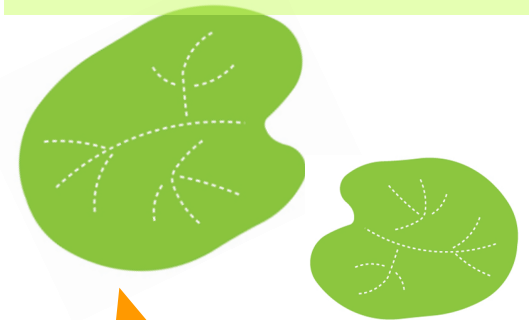
- A warm, developmentally appropriate and engaging environment
- Teachers trained in supporting children with hearing loss
- Healthy snack provided daily
- Partial integration with typically developing peers
- Additional IFSP services provided on site (speech, physical, and occupational therapy) as appropriate
- Children are strongly encouraged to wear listening equipment which will be checked daily by trained staff
- Busing available

WHO CAN JOIN:

Child must be at least 18mos old to begin & may continue until transition into Preschool OR until their 3rd birthday.

Although specialized for children with diagnosed hearing loss of any type, any child with language delays will be considered.

If your child has a developmental delay, ranging from auditory/oral to requiring ASL, LEAP is the perfect program for them and your family!
